## Civic Trust Awards 2005 Awards Presentation Evening

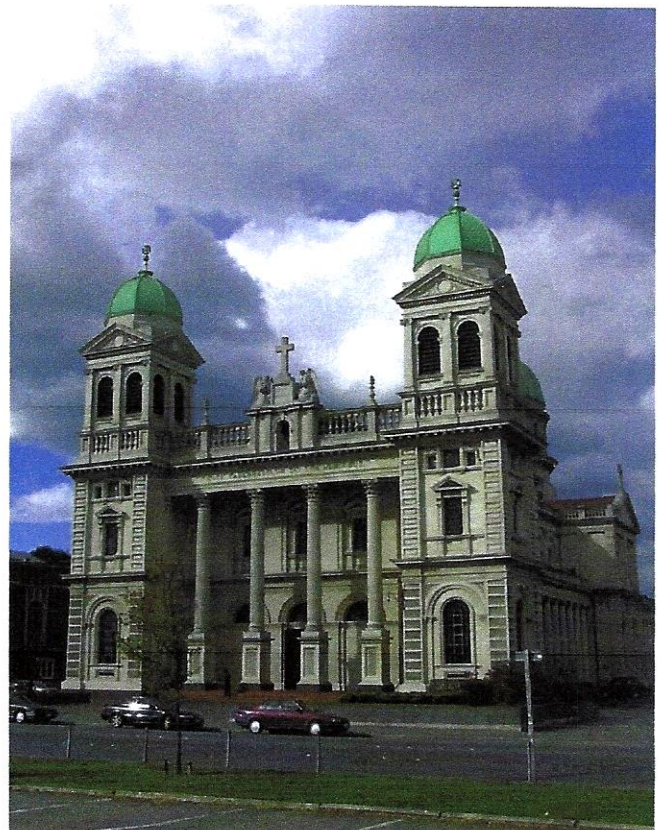

### SUPREME AWARD

#### **The Redevelopment of the Theatre Royal Gloucester Street**

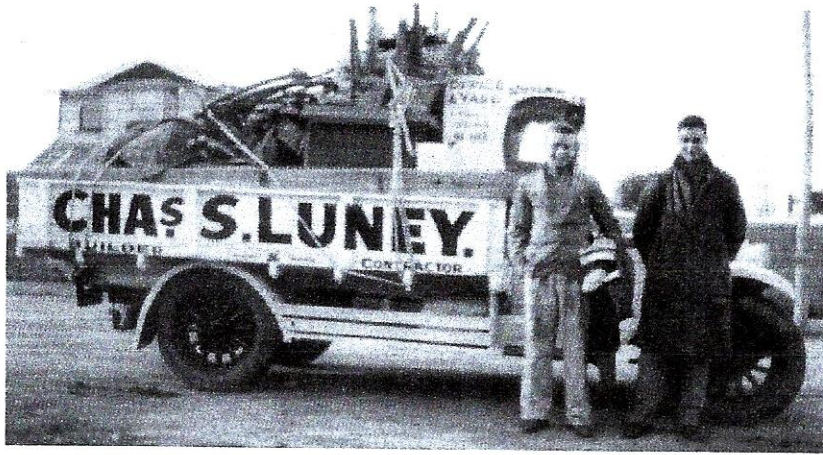
Awarded for the extensive upgrade of this Edwardian theatre to create a significantly enhanced performing arts venue. Front of house there are new levels of comfort with a complete rebuild of the back of house facilities revealed through a wider proscenium arch.



### SUPREME AWARD

#### **Refurbishment of The Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament, Barbadoes St**

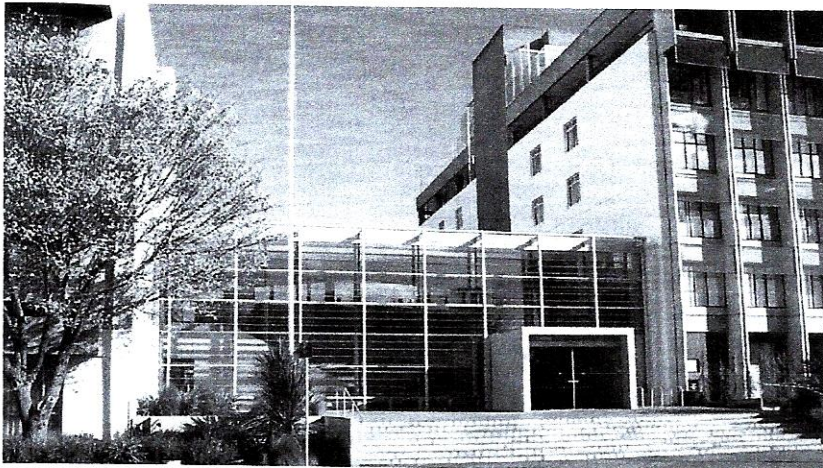
Awarded in the centenary year of opening, in recognition of the completion of 35 years of significant structural and liturgical changes to the Cathedral. Restorative work has been discrete and the new furnishings have enhanced the architecture of the interior in a modern way.



## SPECIAL AWARD

### Chas S Luney Ltd

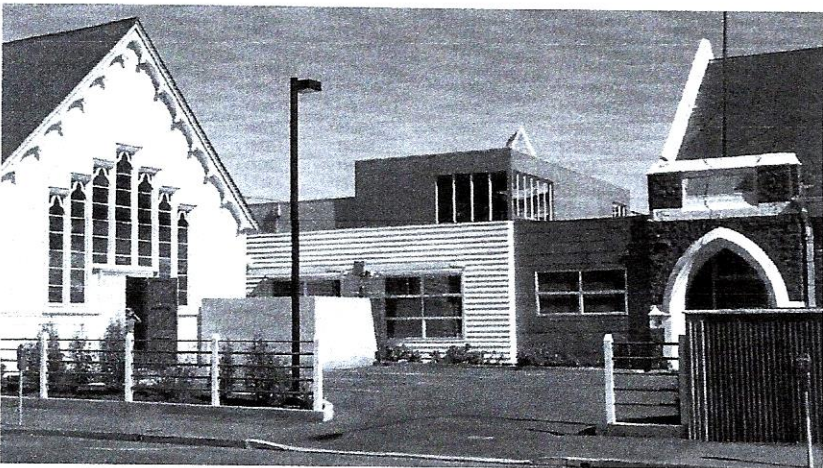
Awarded to this iconic firm which in 2005 ceases to be involved in construction after 79 years and celebrates the 100th birthday of its founder, Charles Luney. The legacy for Christchurch is a fine collection of important civic, commercial and residential buildings.



## AWARD

### Environment Canterbury Centre Kilmore St

Awarded to this elegant new link building which has a strong emphasis on environmental sustainability.



## AWARD

### St Michaels School Redevelopment Durham St

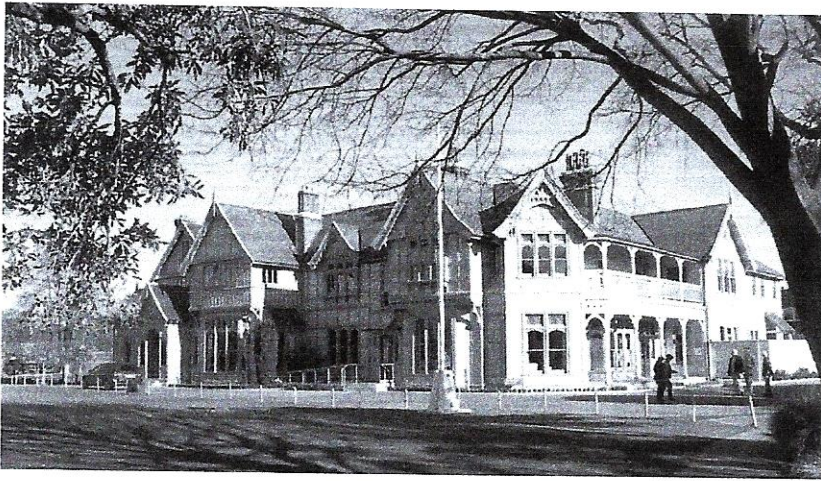
Awarded for a comprehensive site redevelopment that knits together new school buildings within a precinct of historic buildings and trees.



## AWARD

### B J McSherry Ltd / former Lyttleton Harbour Board Building Redevelopment Norwich Quay Lyttleton

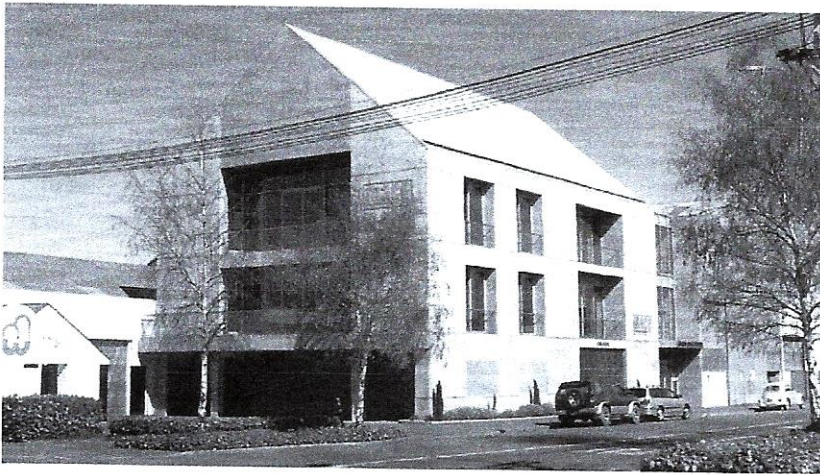
Awarded for the retention and reuse of a landmark historic building with a new purpose built structure that envelopes it in a complimentary way.



## AWARD

### **Restoration of Te Koroha RangiRuru Girls' School Hewitts Road**

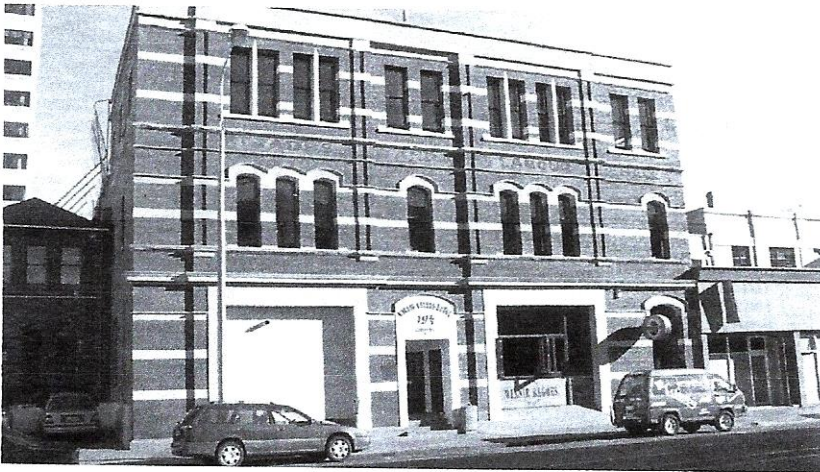
Awarded for the complete refurbishment and the adaptation of the original homestead into the school's administration centre.



## COMMENDATION

### **New Mace Engineering Building Walker St**

Awarded to this bold new office building which is expressive of its industrial neighbours.



## COMMENDATION

### **Winnie Bagoes House Gloucester St**

Awarded for the sensitive retention and reuse of the former Trades and Labour Hall as a new ground level restaurant with offices above.



## COMMENDATION

### **Merivale Manor Papanui Road**

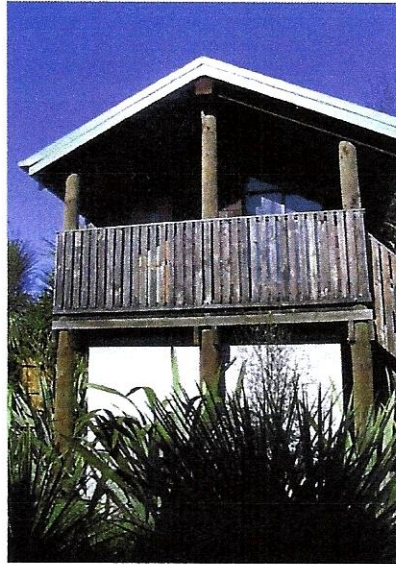
Awarded to this new motel complex incorporating the retention of an 1882 house with complimentary low scale units to the foreground which allow the house to be seen from the road.



## COMMENDATION

### **Tiffany's Restaurant Oxford Terrace**

Awarded in recognition of the 21 years of the successful reuse of this former Hospital Registrar's house as a restaurant.



## COMMENDATION

### **Shands Emporium (far left) Hereford St**

Awarded in recognition of the ongoing retention of this central city commercial building dating from 1860.

## COMMENDATION

### **Addington Bush Society (left)**

Awarded to an ecological network that for 10 years has focused on the restoration and protection of native flora and fauna in Addington.



## JOINT COMMENDATION

### **Holliday & Sons / Hey Judes 18-20 Papanui Rd**

Awarded to these adjoining 19th century shops which have been retained and converted to new commercial uses.
