A recycled 1970s church building transformed into a community resource and vibrant meeting place within a newer Christchurch suburb.

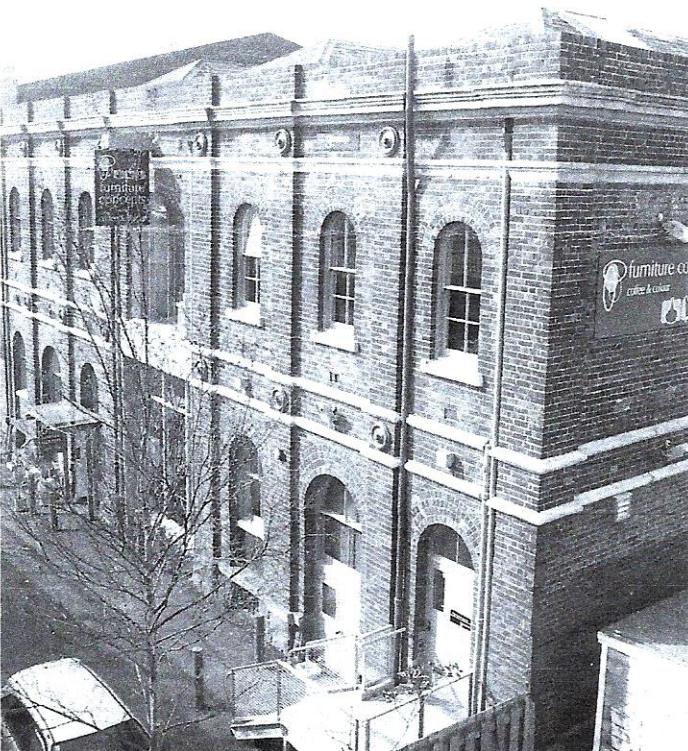

A new restaurant with a well scaled addition situated on a prominent corner within an intact heritage area.

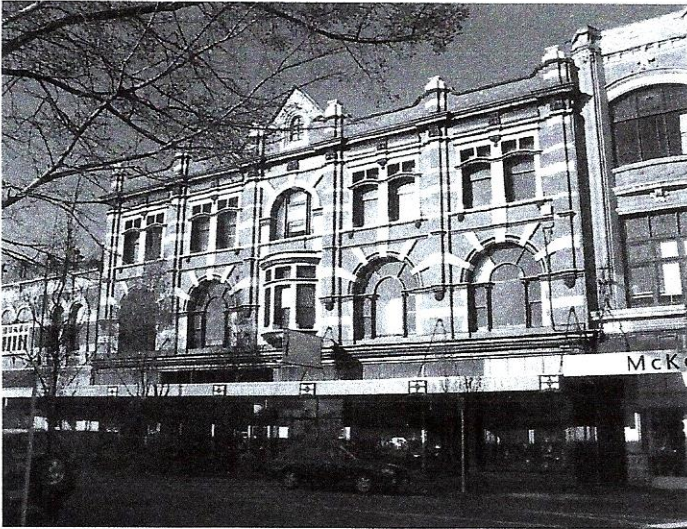

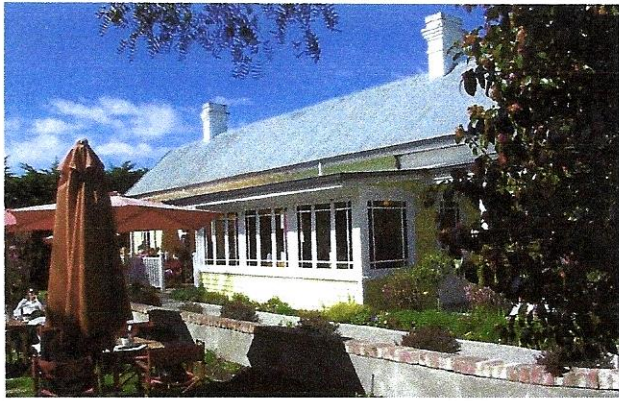

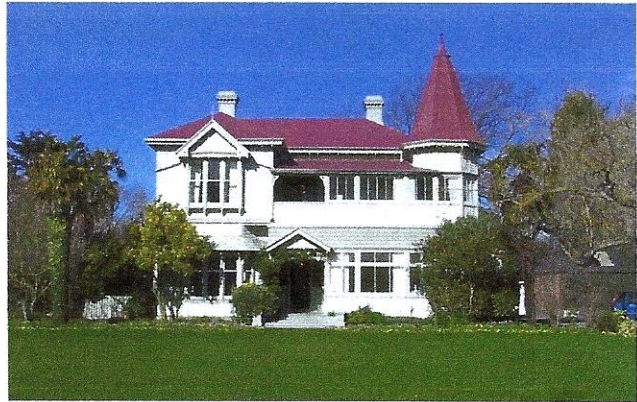

Awarded to the *Christchurch City Council*

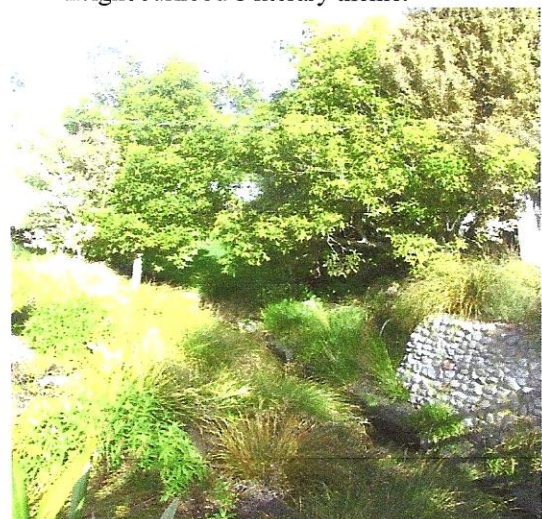
An integration of art into a public place recognising the neighbourhood's literary theme.
